Arrival

The Registration Area will open for check-ins at 5 pm on **Friday**. Please follow the signs to the registration area (in the dining hall) prior to going to the camping area. On-Site Accommodation

Camp Marysville offers great value self catering accommodation for couples, families and small groups. Their two bedroom self catering lodges and one bedroom lodges have been recently refurbished and have everything you will need for your stay, including linens.

Dorms have their own washrooms and showers and may be shared by up to 8 individuals. We will designate male and female dorms. Bring your own sheets/ sleeping bag, pillow and towels for the dorms.

Dorm room beds are \$35 per person per night, or to upgrade from camping, it's just an extra \$10 per person per night. If you'd like to upgrade you can let us know when you arrive. There's lots of space!
