Information needed to obtain Nonresident Temporary Importation Approval Letter from EPA

Nonconforming motor vehicles may be temporarily imported into the U.S. by a nonresident for personal use by the owner (importer) for a period not to exceed one year. Only individual nonresidents may import a vehicle through a nonresident exemption. The conditions of this temporary exemption are:

- Vehicle may not be sold or otherwise transferred to another party in the U.S.;
- Exemption is voided if the vehicle is either used for commercial purposes, or used principally by any person other than the owner (or spouse of the owner); and
- Vehicle must be exported after one year, or upon the nonresident departing the U.S., whichever comes first.

To obtain a Nonresident Temporary Importation Approval Letter from EPA; please provide the following information in a letter that is signed by the requestor/importer:

- 1. Your full name, current foreign address, phone number, Fax number, and email address (if applicable)
- 2. Your U.S. address, phone number, Fax number, and email address (if applicable)
- 3. Vehicle year, make, model and Vehicle Identification Number
- 4. A statement explaining the reason for your visit to the United States. (work/school/vacation).
- 5. The date of the importation
- 6. Location of the vehicle and the Nonresident at the time of request.
- 7. The duration of the importation.
- 8. Proof of ownership (Registration or title documents from country of origin).
