

TOURIST PERMIT EXTENSION REQUIREMENTS FOR 90 MORE DAYS OF TOURISM

Every foreigner who enters Chile for recreation, sports, health, studies, business negotiations, family, religious or other similar purposes, without the motive to immigrate to reside or to conduct paid activities, is considered a tourist.

You can request an extension of your tourist visa if you wish to extend your stay in Chile for another 90 days from the expiration date of your first tourist permit.

Note: This permit costs \$100 USD (one hundred US dollars), equivalent in local currency, regardless of nationality.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Original valid passport and one photocopy of this passport (identification page, passport number, passport issue and expiration dates). In the event that you entered Chile with an ID, you must present the original Identification Document and a photocopy of this ID.
- 2. Original Tourist Card and one clear photocopy of this Tourist Card.

IMPORTANT:

The request must be made in person by the applicant, during the last 30 days of validity of the existing tourist permit, at Extranjería (Matucana 1223, Santiago) or in the offices of the corresponding provincial government.

ALL OF THESE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESSES ARE FREE OF CHARGE, EXCEPT FOR THE COST OF THE RIGHTS CORRESPONDING TO YOUR RESIDENCY OR FINES, WHICH CAN ONLY BE PAID IN BANKS.

THE PRESENTATION OF YOUR APPLICATION DOES NOT REQUIRE A REPRESENTATIVE OR A THIRD PARTY. IN THE CASE OF APPLICATIONS REQUESTED BY A THIRD PARTY, AN AUTHORIZATION SIGNED IN FRONT OF A NOTARY BY THE APPLICANT WILL BE REQUIRED.
