Visit this exceptionally farmhouse just outside Shigatse towards Lhasa, completely self-supporting and run by blind schoolchildren, founded by the Dutchman Paul Kronenberg and his German partner, the blind German Sabriya Tenberken, author of the famous books: 'Mein Weg führt nach Tibet' ("My path leads to Tibet ") about a blind girl riding a horse on the way to Tibet and 'das Siebte Jahr' ("With different eyes") on the results of 7 years Braille Without Borders.
